Definition: the act or an instance of placing two or more things side by side often to compare or contrast or to create an interesting effect.

Task:

Combine 2 (or more) unlikely photographs together using Photoshop. Both photos need to be taken by you. You will need to use the cropping/selection tool and layers in Photoshop.

You will need to create 3 finished images using your own photos. You can use 1 sourced image in 1 photo of your collection.



Ex: fish with shoes on its fins, person with a plant growing out of their head, etc...

Considerations:

- Which photographs will you take? They shouldn't naturally go together—think of strange or unlikely combinations.
- Where are photos being taken? Inside vs. Outside.
- You can work in B&W (use an adjustment layer) or colour or a combination of both.
- All Photographic basics apply -> focus, having a 'star,' proper contrast/exposure, Rule of Thirds, POV, etc.
- Images must work seamlessly together! Blending (Layer Mask) and Cut/Paste (Selection Tools) skills will be tested.

Postproduction:

- Upload your photos to your computer.
- (x3) Combine your contrasting images -> Selection Tools, Crop, Cut/Paste, Move Tool,
 Layers, etc.
- Save your finished pieces as LastFirstJux. (.jpeg)
 - o Ex. SmithBobJux
- Hand in your 3 finished images with the Self-Assessment Form.
