


Image Cutting Tutorials

1. Make sure to download/copy these files from the website.




2. In Photoshop, under FILE select OPEN and choose the Volcano file.


3. Now OPEN the DipperMabel image. This will create a new tab in Photoshop. It should look something like this.




4. In the DipperMabel file, under LAYER (on the top bar) select **Duplicate Layer...** this will create the layers of the same image.




5. Make sure you are on the new layer. Select the **Quick Selection Tool**. You can adjust the size of the cursor the same as with a paintbrush.
6. Now select over Dipper and Mabel in the photo. They should have a glowing, dotted line around their outline.




7. Select the **Move Tool** and drag the Dipper and Mabel towards the Volcano Tab. Remember to hold the mouse button down.
8. Once volcano is on, let go of the mouse button. To adjust the placement and size of Dipper and Mabel, to EDIT and select **Free Transform...** Press Return when you are finished.



9. Now OPEN the file named soosscared. This will open in a separate Tab.
10. Under LAYER select **Duplicate Layer...**
11. Select the Polygonal Lasso Tool, and go around the outline of Soos. When you get near the end, the lasso will have a small circle in the corner (this lets you know it is going to tie together).



12. Use the Move Tool and drag Soos to the Volcano Tab. Use **Free Transform** to adjust his size and location. Remember to press Return when you are done.



Don't forget to save this file under a different name. There you, go now you've ogt some basics on how to remove images from files.
