


BANANAS ARE BERRIES

Here's what to expect after making an appointment with our office:



Check Wait Times

Check wait times, business hours and Telemedicine clinic locations.



Prepare

Bring your OHIP or method of payment and a list of your current medications with you.




Check-In At Kiosk

When you arrive at the clinic, please register at one of our self registration digital kiosks.



Present OHIP Card

If you are an Ontario patient, you will be required to present your OHIP card at every visit.



Complete a Survey

A medical questionnaire will be sent to your phone, asking questions relevant to your visit.



Start Your Appointment

You will be greeted by a Telemedicine Assistant who will bring you to an exam room, record your medical history, etc.

Bouteille à gaz

- Gaz sous pression
- Produits chimiques sous pression

Corrosion

- Lésions oculaires graves
- Corrosion cutanée
- Corrosif pour les métaux

Point d'exclamation

- Danger pour la couche d'ozone*
- Irritation (cutanée ou oculaire)
- Sensibilisation cutanée
- Toxicité aiguë (nocif)
- Toxicité pour certains organes cibles (sommolence ou vertiges ou irritation des voies respiratoires)

Environnement

- Toxicité pour organismes aquatiques*

Aucun pictogramme n'est attribué à certaines classes de danger, par exemple les poussières combustibles et les asphyxiants simples, et à certaines catégories de danger qui correspondent à un danger moins grave. Les produits chimiques sous pression, catégories 1 et 2, doivent être représentés par le pictogramme de flamme et par le pictogramme de bouteille à gaz. Les matières autoréactives (type B) et les peroxydes organiques (type B) doivent être représentés par le pictogramme de flamme et par le pictogramme de bombe explosant.
