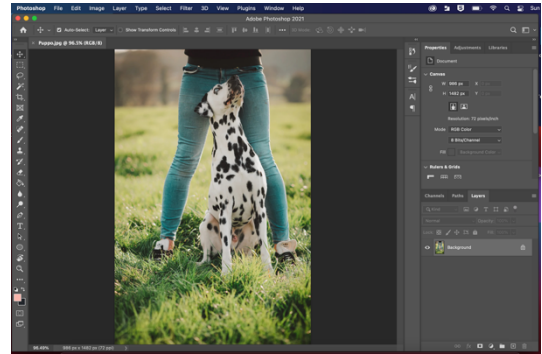
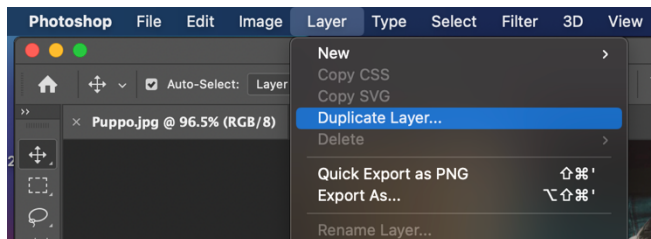


## Photoshop Treatment – Black & White Effect

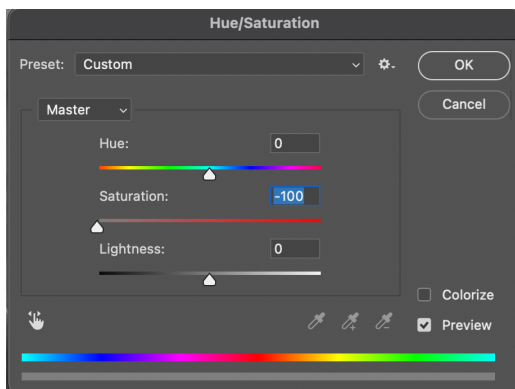
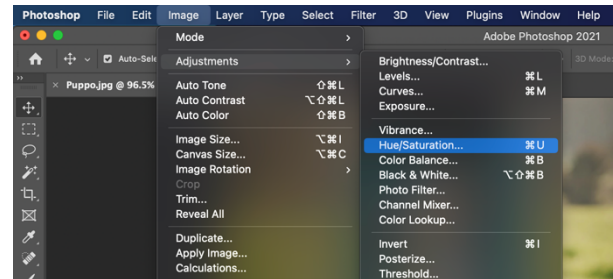
Black & White photos are a great way to add intrigue to an image. Removing colour can evoke emotions of seriousness or vulnerability in the audience or help to focus all attention onto the subject.

Creating this effect is really easy to do in Photoshop. Let's take a look...

1. Open your photo in Photoshop. No need to create a new file for this.
2. Go to the Layer menu and select Duplicate Layer. This will allow you easily undo any changes if you don't like how they go.



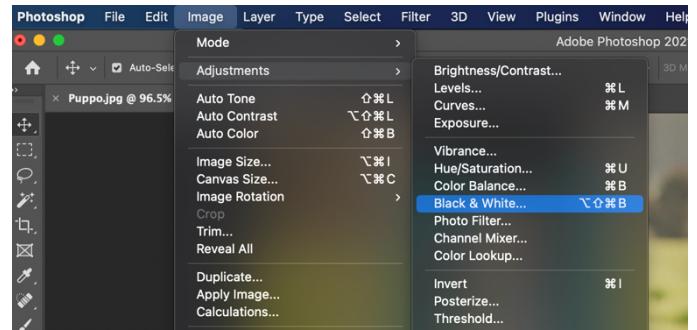
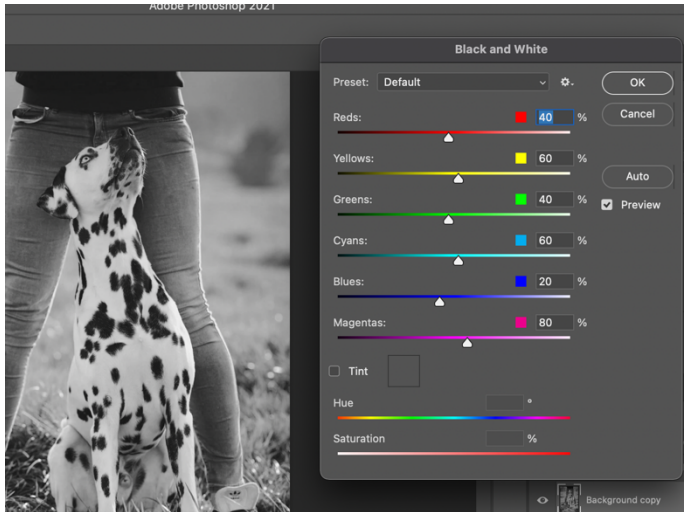
3. With your top layer selected, go to the Image menu, and select -> **Adjustments -> Hue/Saturation.** This will bring up a pop-up window.



4. In this pop-up window change the **Saturation slider to -100**. You can adjust the Lightness slider as you see fit.
5. You're done! Save your file and be on your way!

If that was too many steps, here's another way....

1. Follow Steps 1 and 2. When you get to Step 3, choose Black & White in Adjustments.
2. A pop-up menu will appear. Press Ok.



3. That's it! Save your photo and be on your way.
