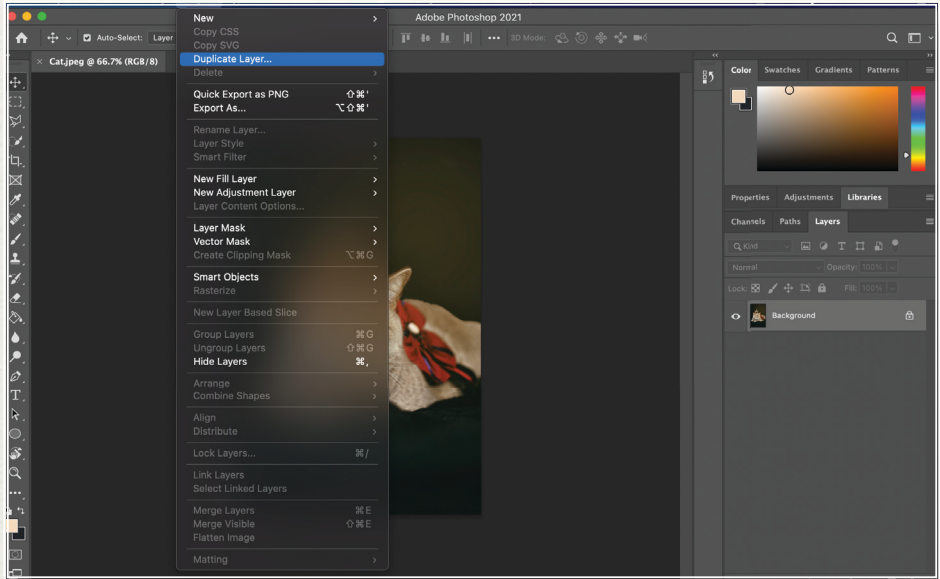


Photoshop How To: Colour Tint

Tinted colour photos can help add a cool or warm effect to an image. Check out these steps for making this style in Photoshop.

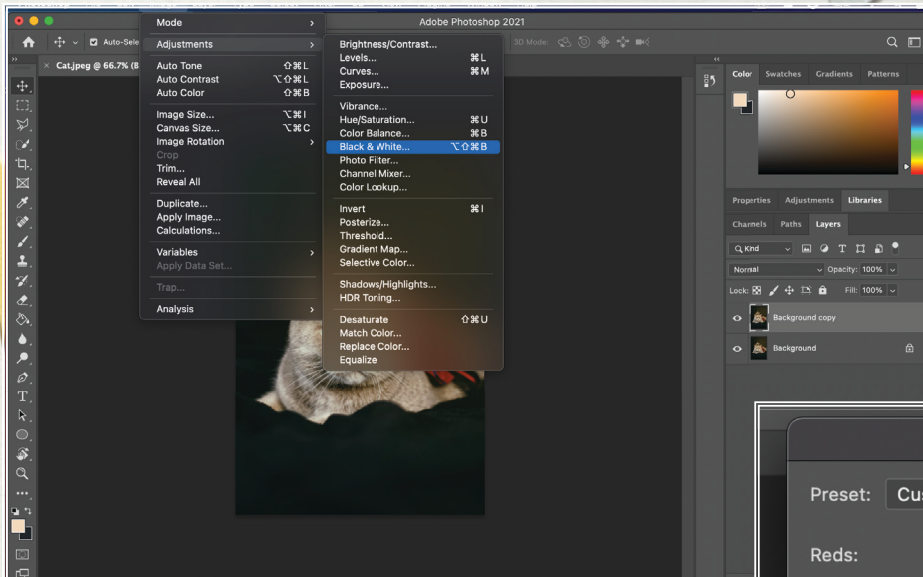
STEP 1:

Open your image in Photoshop.
Go to Layer -> Duplicate Layer



STEP 2:

With your duplicate layer selected,
go to Image -> Adjustments ->
Black and White



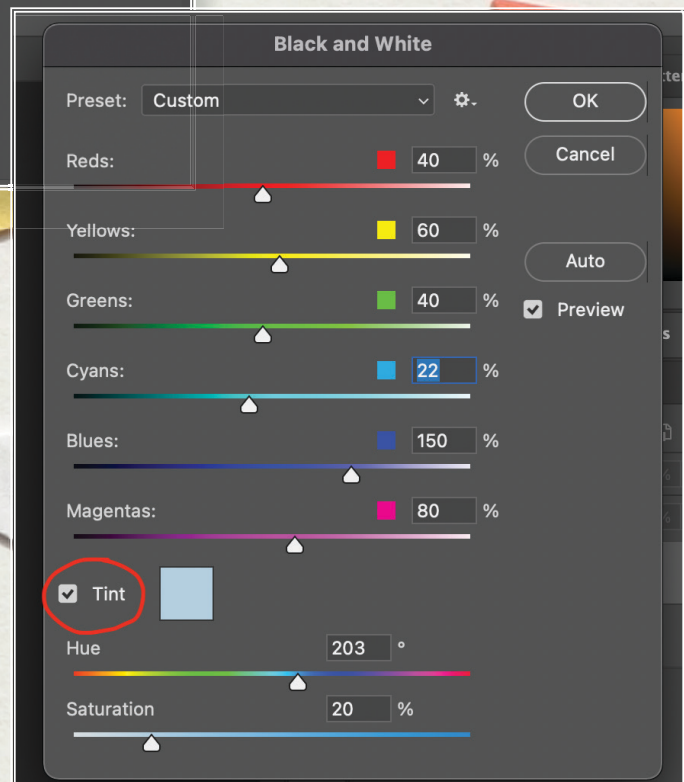
STEP 3:

In the Pop-Up Window, click the Tint box and
make adjustment to the Hue Slider.

You can also make adjustments to the other
sliders as you fit.

Once you are done, press OK and you're done.

Make sure to save your image when done.



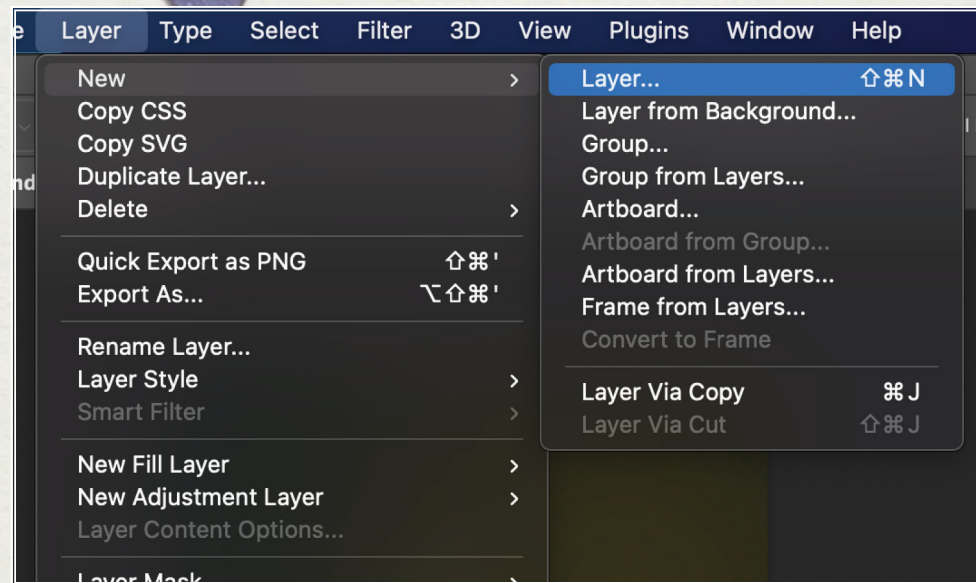
Photoshop How To: Colour Tint - Version 2

STEP 1:

Open your image in Photoshop.
Go to Layer -> Duplicate Layer

STEP 2:

Next, got to Layer -> New Layer

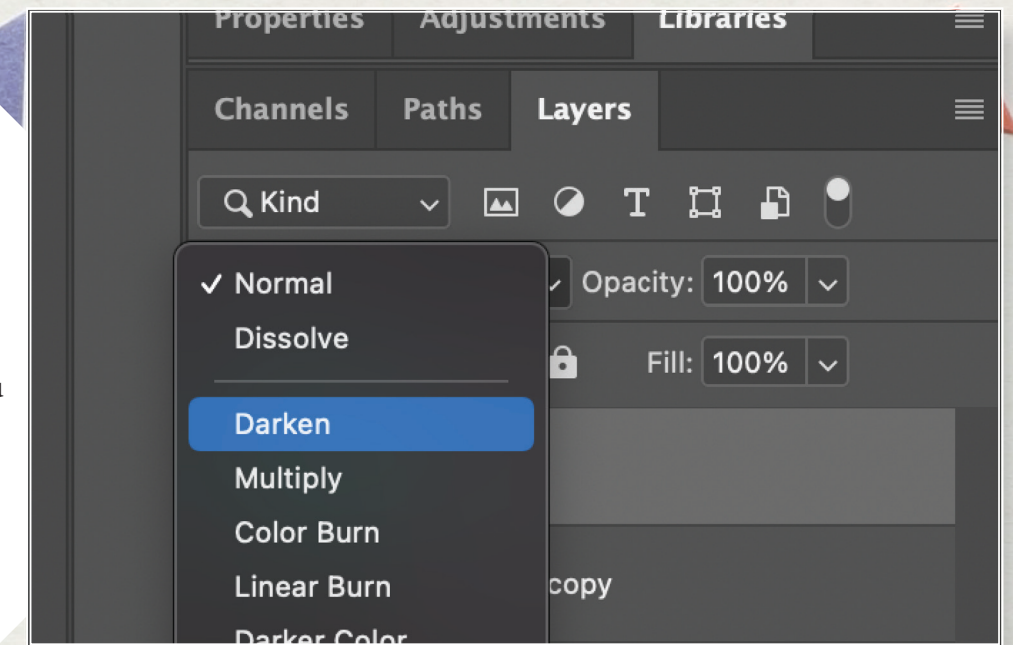


STEP 4:

In your Layers Panel go to the
Blending Mode Menu
(it will say Normal)

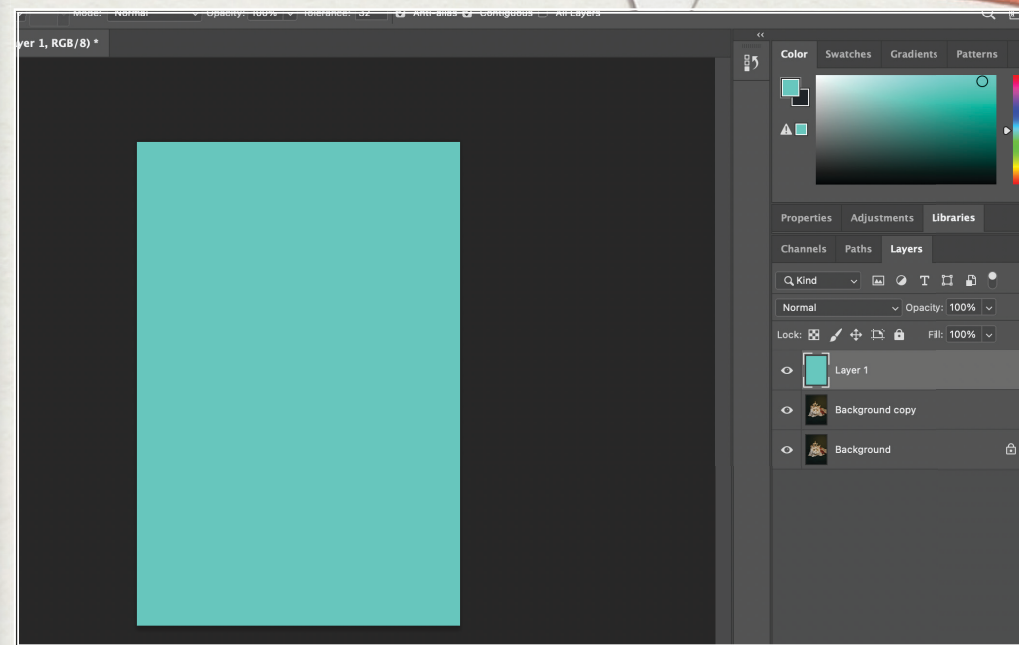
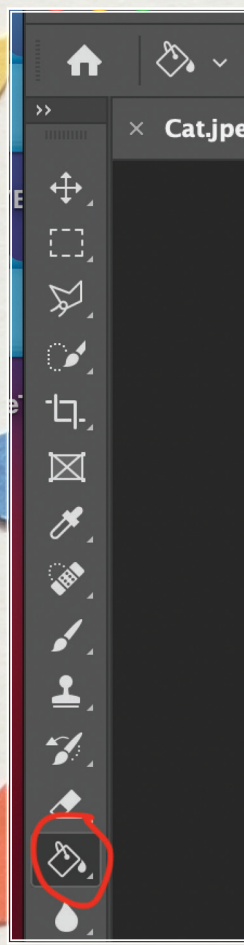
Now select a blending mode that you
like. You can also adjust Opacity to
lighten or strengthen the effect.

You're all done!
Remember to save your work!



STEP 3:

Change your active colour and choose the Paint Bucket Tool (G)
Click your picture to fill in the canvas with you colour.
