

In the final part of this project, you will need to edit all your photos from Part 1 and compile them into a coffee table book using InDesign.

**What is a coffee table book?** This type of book is a conversation starter, inspiration creator, or think piece. Primarily composed of photos and short captions. This type of book has a different feel and design compared to a yearbook, a magazine, an anthology, or novel. Check out this [link](#) for some examples.

### Book Specifications:

- Created using InDesign.
- Must have a cover that includes the following:
  - o Title: Photo Art Project
  - o Your Name
  - o Course and Term: Yearbook
- All content pages must have a black background.
- 1 – 4 photos per page.
  - o Each page must have 1 dominate photo (larger than the others on the page).
- At least 2 larger captions within the book.
  - o These can be quotes, song lyrics, your own writing, etc.

### Considerations and Planning Ideas:

- Think about the photos you will use.
  - o Do they have a theme? Similar traits?
    - Photos of food, activities, friends, locations, etc.
  - o The types of photos you use will help you figure out the best edit styles.
    - Ex. Portraits will work well with 3-D Glasses or Black & White
    - Ex. Landscape photos work well with Colour Isolation
  - o If you have a mix of photo subjects, pair them up with similar ideas.
    - All food photos together, all outdoor photos together, etc.
- Photo Framing
  - o Work with the Stroke tools in InDesign.
    - Add borders and styles to help your photos look more professional on the pages.
- Captions
  - o Use writing that draws on the topics/subjects in your photos.
  - o Look up ideas if you are stuck.
  - o Work with the Text Menus to add more interest to the text.
    - Sizing, Typefaces, Colour, Effects

## **Marking Criteria**

### **Technical (18 marks)**

- All Book Specifications Completed.

### **Creative (18 marks)**

- All photos edited using at least 2 specific styles.
  - o All photos must be taken by you.
- Layout and Design of pages.
  - o Use of Frames, Stroke (Borders)
- Clear theme present throughout photos, captions, design choices.
