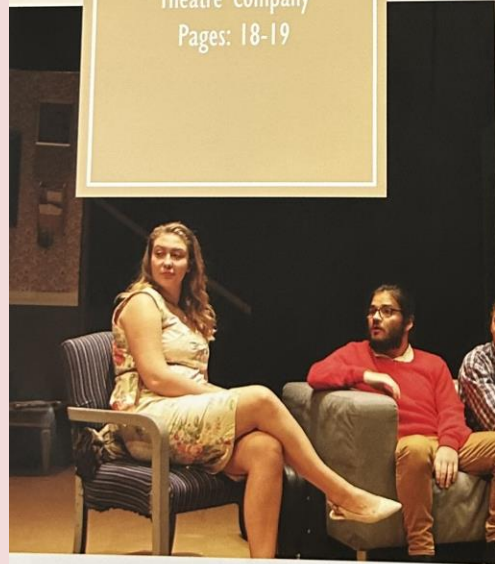

I really like the way they show everyone who is in the club in a photo, and you get to see who is in what club and what everyone's hobby's are! The details are very well done and thought through.

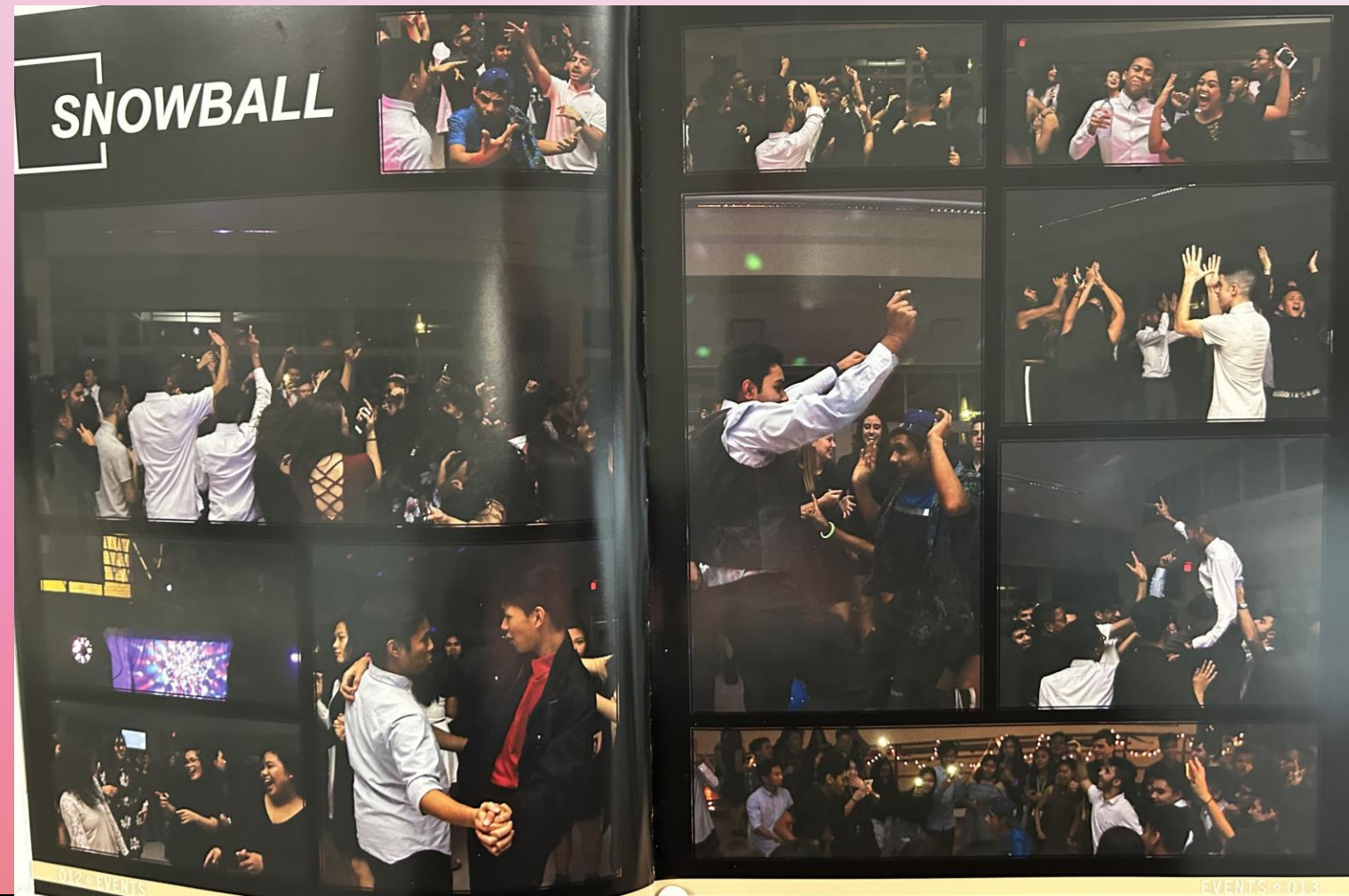

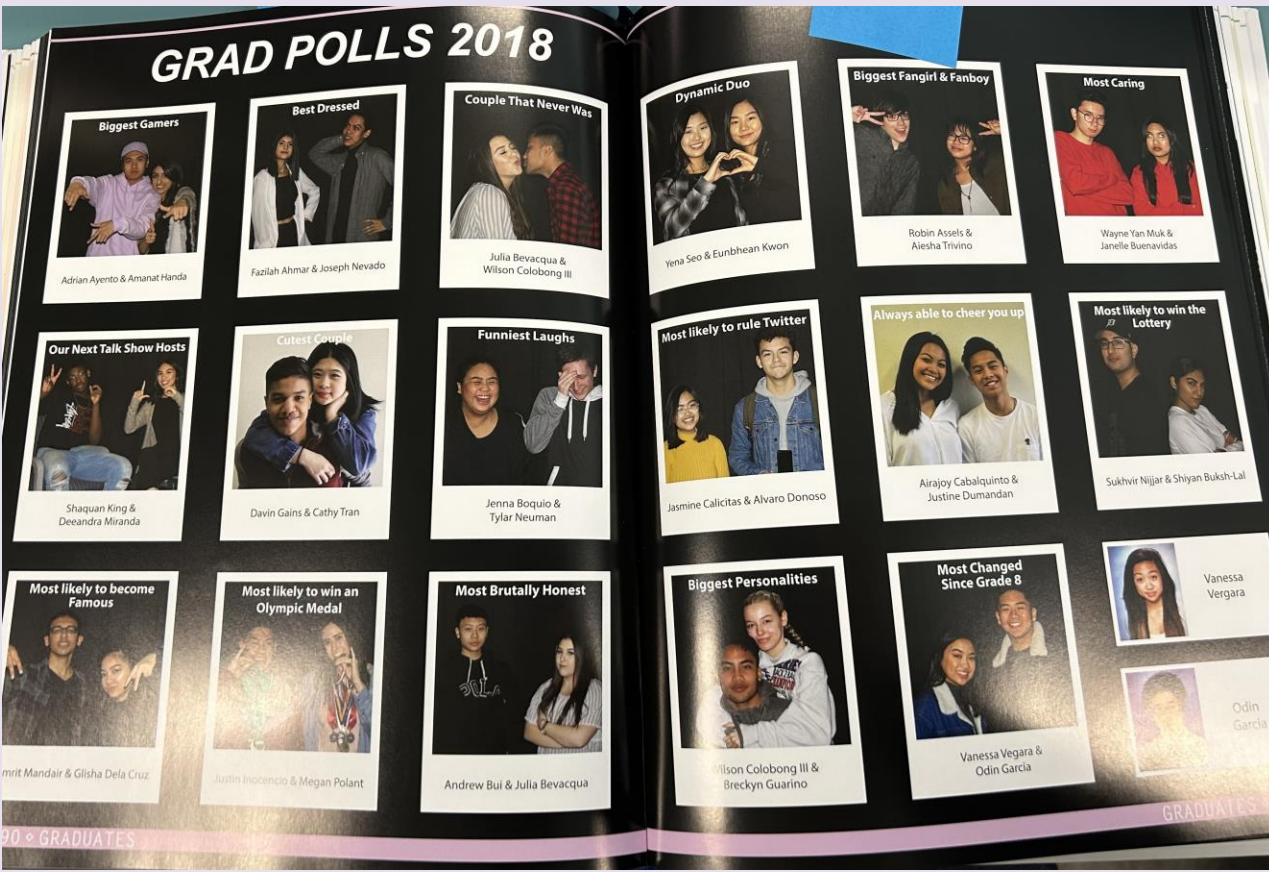

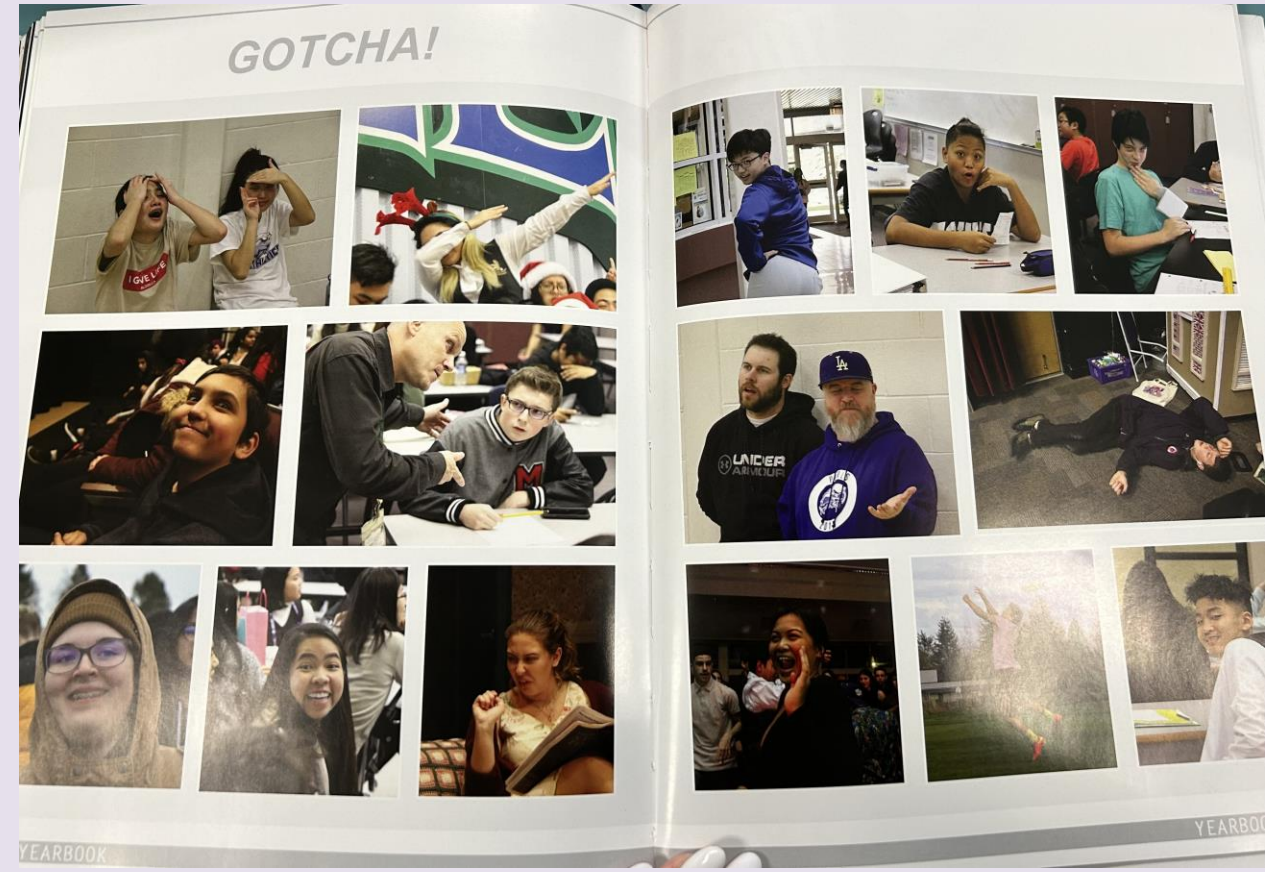
